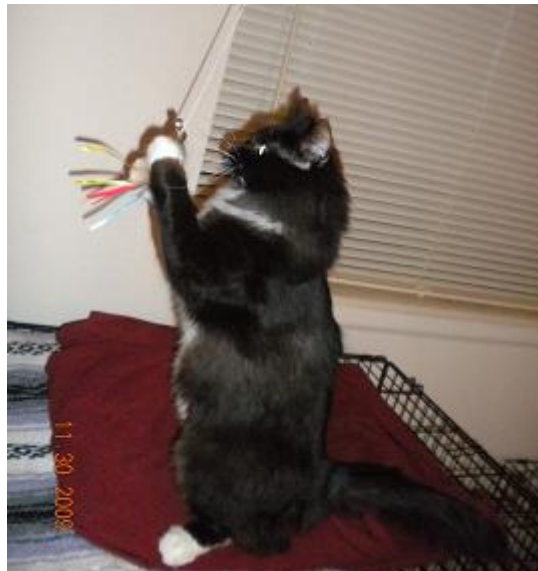

Product of the Month:

Fleas can be found all year, but with the weather getting warmer they are going to be more prevalent. To keep your pets protected we have a few different types of flea preventatives. Keeping your pet on flea prevention will not only protect them from fleas, but it will also help prevent tapeworms since tapeworms are transmitted by fleas. The preventatives we offer include:

Comfortis. This is a fast acting flea preventative for dogs. It is a chewable beef flavored tablet that begins working in as little as 30 minutes and will continue working for 4 weeks. It is given once a month to eliminate fleas on your dog and prevent future infestations.

Frontline Plus. This is a topical flea and tick preventative for dogs and cats. It kills fleas, flea eggs, and ticks. It is absorbed by the body within 24 hours of application, kills fleas and ticks for an entire month, it is gentle enough for kittens and puppies, and pregnant or nursing mothers.

Advantage Multi. This is a prescription heartworm and flea preventative sold only by veterinarians. It will prevent heartworms and fleas, but will also help control intestinal parasites such as roundworms and hookworms in dogs and cats, whipworms in dogs, and earmites in cats. This is also a topical, and it is recommended to keep pets away from each other and from children until it has dried.

Since Advantage Multi is a heartworm preventative we do require that your dog have a negative heartworm test on file.

We all know they sell flea "preventatives" at your local pet stores and drug & grocery store. However, these products can be extremely dangerous even fatal. These product have been known to burn the pets skin, paralyze and other neurological problem and yet your pet may still have fleas.
