All dogs must be current on all vaccines, including DHLPPC, Bordetella, and Rabies. Furthermore dogs must have had a negative heartworm test and fecal test done within the last year. They must be current on both heartworm prevention and flea prevention that has been purchased from a licensed veterinarian office. All cats must be current on all vaccines, including FVRCP, Feline Leukemia, Rabies, and Feline Bordetella. Cats must have also had a negative fecal test done within the past year.
